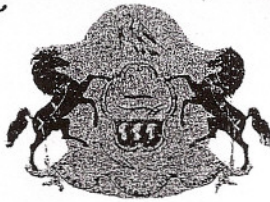

A PROCLAMATION
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF BEAVER
IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF APRIL 12TH THROUGH APRIL 18TH, 2009, AS
"NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK"
IN BEAVER COUNTY.

WHEREAS, in one year over 240 million emergency calls will be placed in the United States; and

IN BEAVER COUNTY.

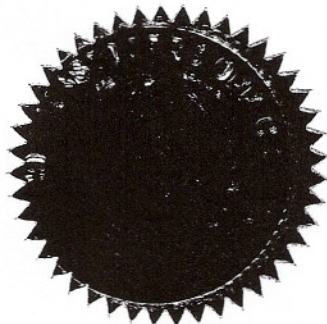
